1. Keio Affiliated Schools Study Abroad Program

Keio Affiliated Schools Study Abroad Program has sent a total of 26 students to boarding schools in the UK and US since the 2014 academic year. Each study abroad student receives a scholarship for the tuition and fees of the host school. The students are highly regarded at the host schools, not only from an academic perspective, but also for their involvement in a wide variety of activities including music and sports. From the 2019 academic year, study abroad for second-year junior high school students began. It is planned to continue increasing the number of study abroad destinations in the future.
