1)Support to produce English papers

2)Employment training for top-level postdocs, etc.

Employment of foreign nationals as early career researchers, such as postdocs, capable of writing English papers that have a high impact factor

- Outline:

To accept applications and recruit foreign nationals as researchers (non- tenured), employment training has been taking place since 2017.

3)Inviting top-class researchers

- Outline:

Since May 1, 2018, Dr. David Farber (US citizen), a renowned individual in the field of cybersecurity, has been invited (employed) as a foreign researcher under the special category.

He is currently a co-director of the Cyber Civilization Research Center, a KGRI research project, and is working on implementing campus-wide initiatives.

Through his research activities spanning over 50 years, Professor David Farber (Distinguished Professor) has established foundations in the fields of electronics, programming languages, and distributed computing, and has made significant contributions toward the promotion of science. These outstanding achievements were recognized and praised by many scientists working in the fields of information, computing, and communication, and as a result, he was elected a fellow of the prestigious American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS; the world's largest academic society). 4) Implementation of archived lecture series (KGRI Lecture Series and KGRI Great Thinker Series)

- Outline:

5) Overseas caravan

- Outline:

To disseminate Keio's research achievements to the world, Keio's faculty members and researchers go overseas to give lectures and research presentations. International research collaboration and the production of international coauthored papers on research outcomes are promoted for the 3 research initiatives of "Longevity," "Security," and "Creativity."
