- 3. The first screening (Written Exam) and the second screening (Interview) will be conducted in Mita Campus. Please understand that applicants who are unable to come to Mita Campus cannot join the screenings. If there is any change to examinations, Graduate School of Economics will let applicants know about it on the website. The application fee will be refunded if applicants could not come to Mita Campus because of immigration restrictions or other reasons related to the impacts of COVID-19.
- 4. Due to the impact of COVID-19, a number of countries have limited their postal services, and some international postal services are experiencing unpredictable delays. Applicants residing outside Japan are required to upload their application materials on the Online Registration as well as sending them by post.
