- •The admission fee and the Student Health Care Mutual Aid Association registration fee (100 yen), which is included in other fees, are only collected in the first year and are not included in the total academic fees for current students.
- The above amounts also apply to students who have graduated from a Keio University undergraduate faculty or graduate school.
- •Academic fees and expenses (excluding the admission fee) and other fees can be paid in two installments at the end of April for the Spring Semester and the end of October for the Fall Semester. However, part of the other fees is collected as a lump sum in the Spring Semester.
- •Other fees which are collected by the university on behalf of other organizations may be revised during the course of a student's attendance.
- \*1 This is the academic fees and expenses for a student who enrolls beyond the standard study period of 1 year and remains enrolled for a full year in the second year (when enrolled part-time for one year).
- \*2 This is the academic fees and expenses for a student who enrolls beyond the standard study period of 1 year and remains enrolled for 6 months in the second year (when enrolled part-time for half a year).
