

Measures at Hiyoshi Campus relating to  
the “Use of campus facilities (from the Fall Semester)”  
[Keio University Hiyoshi Campus Office] updated on October 20, 2021

Keio University has issued a separate announcement on the “Use of Campus Facilities (From the Fall Semester 2021).” Accordingly, the following measures have been put in place at Hiyoshi Campus based on this policy. Please cooperate with the prescribed measures to prevent infections (wear masks, disinfect hands, undergo temperature checks when entering buildings, record entry to buildings, etc.) that will continue to be implemented when entering each building on campus. We ask for everyone’s kind understanding in light of the current situation while apologizing for the inconvenience. Please also be aware that the handling of the following may change without forewarning:

○ Access management regulations for each building on Hiyoshi Campus

[Area A]

Third Building, Fourth Building (Section A, Section B, Independence Wing), Sixth Building, Cafeteria Building, Student Union Building, Raiosha (excluding Faculty Lounge), and Hiyoshi Library

→ Area management will be conducted at the time of entry. Please enter upon completion of measures to prevent infections via the entrance (marked ☆ or ○ on the attached map) located on the side of the cherry blossom tree-lined approach to the Fourth Building

[Area B] Fujiyama Memorial Hall, Second Building, and Seventh Building

→ Area management will be conducted at the time of entry. Please enter upon completion of measures to prevent infections via the entrance (marked ☆ on the attached map)

[Collaboration Complex (dedicated floors of the Graduate School of Business Administration (KBS), Graduate School of System Design and Management (SDM), and Graduate School of Media Design (KMD), including the Kyoseikan Library)]

→ Please comply with the instructions of each graduate school.

[Access management by building: Eighth Building, Sports Building, Keio University Health Center, Sports Medicine Research Center, Hiyoshi Commemorative Hall]

→ Measures to prevent infections will be conducted as before at each building.

○ For the Keio Boys Senior High School and Futsubu Junior High School, please carry out the measures (go to school) as instructed by each school.

Please cooperate with the measures to prevent infections based on the same criteria employed at other buildings, etc., that will be implemented when entering the Hiyoshi Campus Office. The acceptance of applications for the external loan of facilities or entry to campus for tours (outdoor), etc., will be suspended for the foreseeable duration of the access management regulations accompanying the partial resumption of face-to-face classes.

○ All persons passing through the campus will be requested to take a partial detour because of passageway restrictions resulting from the area management. We kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation in light of the current circumstances. Furthermore, we entreat everyone that passes through the campus to continue to abide by measures to prevent the spread of infections such as observing cough etiquette. Additionally, we kindly ask everyone to be aware of and cooperate with the instructions, information, etc., issued by the national and Kanagawa prefectural governments when passing through the campus, and that you do not remain on the campus grounds any longer than is necessary.
