## When you receive a positive test result for COVID-19 (undergraduate and graduate students)

Confirm the day that you became symptomatic (the date you underwent the test that returned positive)

Are you a member of a student club or the Athletic Association?

### **YES**

Report to the representative or leader of your organization that you have COVID-19 and inform them of the date you tested positive

NO

Have you seen anyone other than those you live with in the two days prior to testing positive for COVID-19?

N

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## **YES**

Among the people you have seen, is there anyone who can be considered to have been in "close contact"?

Someone with whom you ate or drank together, were within 1 meter of while not wearing a mask, spent an extended period together in close quarters (karaoke, driving, etc.), spent a long time together in an in-person situation (playing board games, mahjong, etc.)

## NO

- There is no one that you need to notify
- Please visit the Keio Health Service Center website and fill out the "report for infectious diseases"

#### YES

- Convey the following information to the persons considered to be close contacts as soon as possible.
- ✓ That you have tested positive for COVID-19
- ✓ The date that you became symptomatic (or the date you received a positive COVID-19 result)
- ✓ That they are considered a close contact and need to self-quarantine for seven days\* starting the day after your last contact with them
- To visit the Keio University Health Center website and submit a "report for infectious diseases"
