

**When you receive a positive test result for COVID-19 (undergraduate and graduate students)**

Confirm the day that you became symptomatic (the date you underwent the test that returned positive)

Are you a member of a student club or the Athletic Association?

**YES**

**Report to the representative or leader of your organization that you have COVID-19 and inform them of the date you tested positive**

**NO**

Have you seen anyone other than those you live with in the two days prior to testing positive for COVID-19?

**YES**

**Among the people you have seen, is there anyone who can be considered to have been in "close contact"?**

Someone with whom you ate or drank together, were within 1 meter of while not wearing a mask, spent an extended period together in close quarters (karaoke, driving, etc.), spent a long time together in an in-person situation (playing board games, mahjong, etc.)

**NO**

**• There is no one that you need to notify**  
**• Please visit the Keio Health Service Center website and fill out the "report for infectious diseases"**

**YES**

**• Convey the following information to the persons considered to be close contacts as soon as possible.**

- ✓ That you have tested positive for COVID-19
- ✓ The date that you became symptomatic (or the date you received a positive COVID-19 result)
- ✓ That they are considered a close contact and need to self-quarantine for seven days\* starting the day after your last contact with them

**Returning to campus after recovering from COVID-19**

\* The period close contacts must self-quarantine is subject to change by the government. Please follow the most recent guidelines.
