

Measures at Hiyoshi Campus Relating to the “Use of Campus Facilities”

Keio University Hiyoshi Campus Office

(Updated on October 1, 2022)

Keio University will implement the following measures at Hiyoshi Campus in accordance with the policies detailed in [“Use of Campus Facilities”](#). Please continue to abide by the prescribed measures to prevent infections (wearing masks, using hand sanitizer, undergoing temperature checks when entering buildings, logging entry, etc.) when entering each building on campus. Please also be aware that the details above may change without warning.

1. Access management regulations for each building on Hiyoshi Campus
 - Area A:** Third Building, Fourth Building (Section A, Section B, Independence Wing), Sixth Building, Cafeteria Building, Student Union Building, Raiosha (excluding Faculty Lounge), Hiyoshi Library
 - Area management will be conducted at the time of entry. Please cooperate with measures to prevent infections when entering the area (at the location marked ☆ or ○ on the attached map)
 - Area B:** Fujiyama Memorial Hall, Second Building, Seventh Building
 - Area management will be conducted at the time of entry. Please cooperate with measures to prevent infections when entering the Fujiyama Memorial Hall. (marked ☆ on attached map).

Collaboration Complex (dedicated floors of the Graduate School of Business Administration (KBS), Graduate School of System Design and Management (SDM), and Graduate School of Media Design (KMD),

including the Kyoseikan Library)

→ Please comply with the instructions of each graduate school.

Access management by building: Eighth Building, Sports Building, Gymnasium, Keio University Health Center, Sports Medicine Research Center, Hiyoshi Commemorative Hall

→ As usual, measures to prevent infections will be conducted at each building.

7. All persons passing through the campus will be requested to take a partial detour because of passageway restrictions resulting from area management. We kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation in light of current circumstances. Furthermore, we ask everyone that passes through the campus to continue to comply with cough etiquette and other measures to prevent the spread of infections. Additionally, everyone should be aware of and cooperate with the instructions, information, etc., issued by the national government and Kanagawa prefectural government when passing through the campus. Please do not remain on the campus grounds any longer than is necessary.
