Please note that among the Academic Fees and Expenses, the registration fee(both types), tuition fee and facilities fee are subject to change from year to year based on a sliding scale system as stipulated in the University Rules and Regulations. The standard for the rate of increase is based on a sliding rate (the rate of increase of the salary of national government employees as announced in the National Personnel Authority's annual salary recommendations in the previous year, etc.).

Among the "Other Fees", the Student Health Care Mutual Aid Association registration fee (100 yen) will only be collected in the first year. This amount is not included in the total academic fees for current students.

The above amounts also apply to students who have graduated from a Keio University undergraduate faculty or graduate school.

Academic fees and expenses (excluding the admission fee) and "Other Fees" can be split into two installments and paid at the end of April for the Spring Semester and the end of October for the Fall Semester. However, part of the "Other Fees" will be collected as a lump sum in the Spring Semester.

• "Other Fees" which are collected by the university on behalf of other organizations may be revised during the course of a student's attendance.

Among the "Other Fees", the Student's Professional Indemnity Insurance will be collected once for each year of enrollment; in April for April enrollees (Spring Semester) and October for September enrollees (Fall Semester).
