European University Institute and Keio University Conclude a Partnership Agreement

Keio University concluded a partnership agreement with the European University Institute (EUI), one of the leading graduate schools in Europe, on Wednesday, June 3, 2020. This agreement sets a framework for expanding cooperation to lead the world in academic research and education.

1. Purpose of This Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to establish a framework for mutual cooperation in research and education, and activities such as academic exchange between researchers, exchange programs for graduate students, and the introduction of dual degree programs are planned.

2. Details of This Agreement

EUI is a graduate school established in Florence (Italy) in 1972 as an intergovernmental organization and has close ties to the European Union (EU), with 24 of its member states being involved with its operations. EUI conducts world-class advanced research and educational activities in the social sciences. The first undertaking under the agreement will be to set up a master's student exchange program between the EUI's School of Transnational Governance and the Keio University Law School (Master of Laws (LL.M) in Global Legal Practice) from 2021, and in the near future, there are plans to introduce a dual degree system between the two schools. Thereafter, similar cooperative relationships will be developed at the various graduate school levels of the two institutions.
