Notice on the AY 2021 Annual Health Checkup for Students Admitted in September (SFC)

The Keio University Health Center holds Annual Health Checkups (health checkups) for all students based on the School Health and Safety Act. The Keio University Regulations also stipulate that “All students should undergo health checkup on an annual basis,” so be sure to take the health checkup.

The university health checkup is held every year in the spring. Please do not forget to undergo the health checkup in the spring (April) of the 2022 academic year.

Note that health checkup examinations including physical measurements may be cancelled or postponed depending on the status of COVID-19 (coronavirus disease) infections.

- The following document cannot be issued if you have not registered for the pre-checkup medical questionnaire.
 - ◇ Issuance of “Certificate of Completion of Medical Questionnaire” verifying that you have taken the online questionnaire.
- If you do not undergo the health checkup examinations including physical measurements, the issuance of the following document and the acquisition of credits for the following courses will not be permitted.
 - ◇ Issuance of “Certificate of Annual Health Checkup”
 - ◇ Credits for “Physical Activity Courses”

Neither the registration for the pre-checkup medical questionnaire nor health checkup examinations including physical measurements will be conducted outside of the designated period; however, please consult separately with the Health Center if during the designated period you will take a temporary leave of absence, are studying abroad, are prohibited from coming on campus because of an infectious disease stipulated by the School Health and Safety Act, are unable to travel to the university due to illness, or are in the middle of the self-isolation period due to a possible COVID-19 infection.

[How to register]

- Access the registration form and fill in the required items.
You can respond using the “Annual Health Checkup Online Questionnaire Form” in Applications on the “Keio Single Sign-On System (keio.jp).”
- At the reception of the health checkup venue for physical measurements, etc., we will check the certificate of completion of the medical questionnaire that appears on the screen after completing the online medical questionnaire.
The student ID number barcode will be required at the reception. Please print it out in advance and bring it with you or have it displayed ready on the screen of your smartphone.

[Important Notes]

- You may be contacted by e-mail at a later date depending on the content of the medical questionnaire.
If you are contacted, please check the instructions and attend a doctor’s consultation if necessary.
- If you would like to discuss considerations for classes and taking courses (credit acquisition), please consult directly with the Office of Student Services on your campus.

[Things to bring on the day of the health checkup]

- Masks (masks made from non-woven fabric recommended): please ensure that you wear a mask on the day.
- “Certificate of Completion of Medical Questionnaire”
- Urine: Read the document titled “How to use the urine container kit” carefully (enclosed with the urine collection kit), and bring a urine sample on the day of the health check.
If you are menstruating, please do not bring a urine sample taken on the day and instead report this at the reception.

[Important notes]

- Please be sure to undergo the health checkup after registering for the pre-checkup medical questionnaire in ① You will not be able to undergo the health checkup if you do not register.
- Please refrain from undergoing the health checkup if you have cold symptoms like a fever.
- If you have any special requirements that need to be taken into consideration when attending the health checkup, please consult with the Health Center in advance.
- If you need them earlier for scholarships or study abroad, apply for the documents on that day at the Health Center. However, please note that the Health Center cannot issue a Certificate of Annual Health Checkup earlier for job applications.

[Results of health checkup examinations including physical measurements]

After the finish of the annual health checkup, the results are available to view will be announced on the university portal site(keio.jp news). Please be sure to confirm the results of your health checkup.
