Most Co-op services are available only in Japan, so please register for membership after you arrive. You can also join after enrolling at the university. For more details, please refer to the documents provided upon your arrival.

What is Keio Co-op?

Keio Co-op is a member-run organization supported and managed by students, staff, and faculty of Keio University. Its goal is to make campus life more convenient and enjoyable.

Why should you become a member of Keio Co-op?

Unlike regular stores, the Co-op is supported by investments from members of the Keio community—students, staff, and faculty. By becoming a member, you can use all Co-op services and facilities, making it an important part of campus life.

How to become a member of Keio Co-op?

To join, students are asked to invest **20,000 yen** (20 shares) in the Co-op.

This amount will be refunded when you graduate, according to the Co-op's bylaws.

- a) Fill out the enclosed application form.
- b) Then, make a deposit at the Japan Post Bank using the payment and deposit form.
- c) Finally, bring a copy of the deposit slip and your application form to the co-op store or send them by post in a reply envelope. After that, it will be possible to display the member's card on the smartphone within 2 to 4 weeks.
