Let's move to the basement floor!

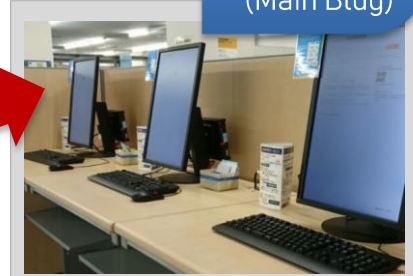

PCs are also available in the library. To log in, you need your own account. Laptops can connect to Wi-Fi by setting up with KeioID authentication.



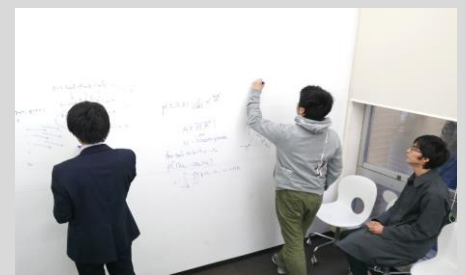
**Reference Desk** offers assistance on resources of the library. (8:45 am to 5 pm on weekdays)
