Protection of Personal Information at Keio University

The International Center at Keio University is committed to the protection and appropriate use of personal information based on Keio University's "Basic Policy Concerning Protection of Personal Information" and "Rules for Protection of Personal Information." Personal information provided for scholarship applications and processes, including Scholarship Registration, shall be used only for screening and selecting scholarship recipients, verifying the qualifications of scholarship recipients, managing scholarship payments and refunds, and verifying the agreements between scholarship recipients and the sponsoring organizations (Keio University, Japanese Government [Monbukagakusho], JASSO, and other awarding organizations). Within a scope that is appropriate for achieving the above purposes, the International Center may disclose personal information about recommended students to sponsors, financial institutions, and other third parties when necessary. However, personal information shall not be used for any other purposes.

< For undergraduate and graduate international students considering scholarships >

The main purpose of all scholarships is to assist highly talented students who excel academically and who are of excellent character but have difficulties continuing their studies due to financial reasons.

This guidebook outlines scholarships for full-time degree, privately-financed international students at the undergraduate and graduate level whose **status of residence in Japan is “Student”**. International Students whose status of residence is “Special Permanent resident,” “Permanent resident,” “Long-term resident,” “Child or spouse of Japanese national (permanent resident),” or those who are a “Dependent” and wish to apply for single-year Keio scholarship should refer to the Keio University Scholarship Information (Undergraduate/Graduate Students) guidebook, which is available on the Student website.

Broadly speaking, scholarships are offered by Keio University, public entities such as Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO), and scholarship organizations including private companies and scholarship foundations. Students may apply through the recommendation of the university or directly to the awarding organizations.

The breakdown of figures of international students who received scholarships in the **2025** academic year is shown in the following pages.

For scholarships from companies and foundations that require the recommendation of the awarding organizations or the university, applicants must go through an internal screening process within Keio University before they undergo evaluation by the companies or foundations. Please note that passing the internal screening process does not mean that the applicant has been selected for the scholarship. Often, a certain level of Japanese proficiency to understand university courses and undergo interviews is required to fill out application documents and go through screening interviews for scholarships offered by companies and foundations. Please make sure to check the required level of Japanese proficiency before selecting scholarships for which you wish to apply.

In addition, you will be disqualified from eligibility to receive payments for many scholarships if you study or intern outside Japan during the period you are in receipt of the scholarship. Please be aware that you should take steps to confirm eligibility criteria when applying for scholarships if you are considering studying or interning abroad.

Japanese Language Program (JLP) Students

Scholarships for students of the Japanese Language Program (JLP) will be announced separately. Please note that the scholarship applications and screening methods for JLP scholarships differ from those outlined in this guidebook.

<How to Apply for Scholarships>

There are two types of scholarships at Keio University:

- 1) The "Individual application" and "Direct application" scholarships in which students themselves can apply directly to the awarding organization.
- 2) The "University application" and "University recommendation" scholarships in which the scholarship organizations send the university a request to post scholarship information.

Additionally, Keio University offers its own scholarships. All students are responsible for confirming the necessary documents and submitting those documents on their own. Scholarships must be applied for directly by the applicant according to the application guidelines for each scholarship. Applications cannot be submitted by 3rd parties on behalf of an applicant. Applications by proxy or by any method other than those specified, such as e-mail or postal mail, will not accepted.

1) Individual Application and Direct Application (Students apply directly to the awarding organization)

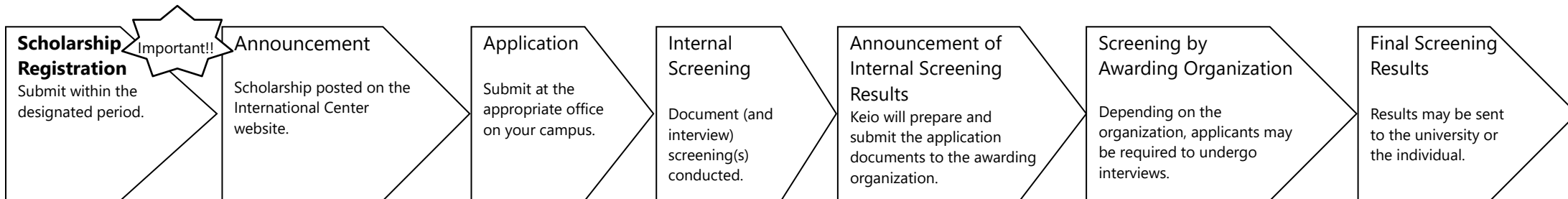
There are two types of scholarships for which students gather all of the required documents and apply directly to the scholarship organizations themselves: "Individual application" scholarships are posted on the "[Scholarships Now Available](#)" page of the International Center website, while information about "Direct Application" scholarships is obtained through the applicant's own search. Generally, application guidelines and pamphlets will be made available on the International Center website or the website of the awarding organization, though some may be distributed at the office in charge of scholarships on your campus.

2) University Application and University Recommendation (Students apply through the university)

University application refers to the application process for scholarships in which students gather all required documents themselves and submit them to Keio University. Keio University will send all required documents to the awarding organization. This type of application does not require any internal screening.

University recommendation refers to the application process in which students apply for the scholarship through Keio University such as Scholarships provided by Keio University / JASSO Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students/Private Foundation Scholarships.

To apply for these scholarships (2), the following is an outline of the application procedures.



※Please check the following page for "Scholarship Registration."

< Scholarship Registration (Important!) >

Scholarship Registration must be completed for students who wish to apply for university application scholarships, university recommendation scholarships, or scholarships for privately financed international students that Keio University provides. This registration is conducted at **the beginning of each semester, twice a year in April and September.** Information concerning scholarship registration and submitting the Scholarship Registration will be posted on the International Center website at the end of each semester (at the end of January and end of July before vacation periods begin).

Please note that **students are unable to apply for scholarships if they fail to complete this registration during the prescribed period.** The schedule for the **2026** Academic Year Scholarship Registration is listed below.

Internal applicant screening at Keio University is based on the Scholarship Registration Forms and Documents. As this Forms and Documents makes up an important part of your application, please fill in every section carefully and in detail. Please be aware that applications may be excluded from selection if any required documents are incomplete, missing, or filled out incorrectly. Please inform the appropriate office on your campus immediately if there have been any changes to information on the Scholarship Registration Forms and Documents you submitted. After submitting the Scholarship Registration Forms and Documents, keep all the submitted documents at hand and be ready to show the originals when required.

Please make your decision on whether to apply after carefully reading through the application guidelines from the awarding organization to confirm the application requirements and scholarship provisions. Choose the scholarships for which you wish to apply and submit the application form(s) to **the Google Form of the appropriate office on your campus**. (Some scholarships may require documents in addition to the application forms. Information about other required documents will be included in the scholarship announcements and on the application forms.)

< Considerations Concerning Application >

Please be aware of the following when applying for scholarships.

1. You can simultaneously apply to several university recommendation scholarships.
2. Even after officially selected to receive a Keio University recommendation to the awarding organization, you can still apply to other scholarships. However, **once a student has been nominated for a scholarship through university recommendation, the student may not decline the scholarship for any reason. Please carefully evaluate your financial need when you consider applying for scholarships with smaller award amounts.**
3. If you are selected to receive both a university recommendation scholarship and an individual/direct/university application scholarship, yet are not allowed to receive both simultaneously, you must give priority to the university recommendation scholarship. Students must take responsibility and withdraw from the individual/direct/university application scholarship themselves. (See " Items to Confirm When Applying for Scholarships Regarding Combining and Receiving Their Funds" on page 8 for more information.)
4. International students who are currently receiving scholarships and who are determined to continue to receive scholarships in the following fiscal year cannot apply for scholarships from other organizations that do not allow simultaneous scholarships. Please read the application guidelines carefully.
5. Once officially selected to receive a university recommendation to the awarding organization, you will not be recommended to other scholarships which do not allow to combine with other scholarships.
6. The university will not disclose the progress of the selection process or reasons for selection.
7. If an applicant has provided any false or misleading information, their application will be revoked.
8. Scholarships for privately financed international students are intended for full-time degree students whose status of residence is "student." Recipients may be disqualified **if they change their status of residence to something other than "student"** or if they are deemed ineligible for the scholarship. In such cases, they may be required to return all or part of their scholarship award. **If students change their status of residence to anything other than "student," they are required to notify the university immediately.**
9. There are some scholarships for which students with outstanding tuition fees cannot apply to.
10. If you decide to receive a direct application scholarship, please make sure to inform the appropriate office on your campus.

< Items to Confirm When Applying for Scholarships Regarding Combining and Receiving Their Funds >

There are four main ways to apply for scholarships from third-parties such as private organizations and local governments.

You may apply for more than one scholarship until you are selected (your nomination for a scholarship has been decided via university recommendation). However, there are some cases in which scholarships from private organizations are not allowed to be used in combination with scholarships from other sources. The following rules determine which scholarship(s) will ultimately be availed to the applicant at the time of their university recommendation or selection by the scholarship organization, depending on the application method. Make sure you understand the following rules before applying for a scholarship.

- Once a student has been nominated for a scholarship through a university recommendation, that student may not decline the scholarship for any reason.
- If you apply for both a scholarship that involves the university's internal selection process AND a scholarship without the internal selection process (i.e., recommendation of all eligible persons, individual application, or direct application in the table above) and are accepted to both scholarships, you must prioritize receiving the scholarship to which you were nominated via university recommendation first, regardless of the amount or timing of the results notification, in the event that combined use of both scholarships is not allowed.

Below are case examples showing which scholarship you will receive if you apply for two or more scholarships that cannot be used together and you are selected for all.

●Case 1: You applied for both scholarships A and B

Scholarship A (University recommendation scholarship): Cannot be combined with private scholarships

Scholarship B (Scholarship via University application; recommendation of all eligible persons): Can be combined with private scholarships

→If you are selected for both scholarships, you will receive scholarship A. (B will be withdrawn.)

●Case 2: You applied for both scholarships C and D

Scholarship C (Scholarship via University application; recommendation of all eligible persons): Can be combined with private scholarships

Scholarship D (Individual application scholarship): Cannot be combined with any private scholarships.

→If you are selected for both scholarships, you will only receive scholarship C. (D will be withdrawn.)

●Case 3: You applied for scholarships E, F, and G together

Scholarship E (University recommendation scholarship): Cannot be combined with private scholarships, but can be combined with internal university scholarships

Scholarship F (Individual application scholarship): Can be combined with private scholarships, and can be combined with internal university scholarships

Scholarship G (Internal university scholarship): Can be combined with private scholarships

→If you are selected for all three scholarships, you will receive scholarships E and G. (F will be withdrawn.)

In addition, please note the following points:

- As a representative of Keio University, recipients are required to attend all scholarship award ceremonies, lectures, receptions, camps, etc., hosted by the scholarship organization.
- Some scholarship organizations require recipients to submit a certificate of enrollment, academic transcripts, and certificate of graduation/completion to the scholarship organization at the end of each academic year.
- If the scholarship organization requires these documents to be submitted through the university, recipients will carry out the necessary steps to obtain the documents and submit them through the university.
- Some scholarship organizations require recipients to submit report detailing their student life at the end of each academic year. Please follow the instructions and submit the report on time.
- There may be instances where information regarding the scholarship recipient is shared with the scholarship organization.

Scholarship Information

Note: scholarship information in this guidebook

Scholarship applications open around September of the previous academic year, and are posted intensively from October to January and from the latter half of March to April. The information about applications and results in this guidebook are from the 2025 academic year. The year of Eligibility is not the student's study year at the time of application, but their study year at the start of scholarship payment. For example, in the case of recruitment in October 2025, if a scholarship that starts payments from April 2026 is intended for third-year undergraduate students, it means not third-year students in October 2025 at the time of recruitment, but those who are in their third year in April 2026, are eligible to apply. In addition, recruitment period and details are subject to change due to the situation of the scholarship providers. Use the information in this guidebook as a reference, and if you plan to apply for any scholarships, make sure to check the International Center website regularly and read the application guidelines for each scholarship you are interested in for details before applying.

Scholarship recruitment information will be posted on the International Center website as soon as it arrives at the university. We cannot answer individual questions regarding the recruitment period and schedule. Please note that the recruitment period may be short and tight.
